CHARM SQUARE SWAP FOR 2020: WE HAVE 21 WONDERFUL CHARM "SWAPPERS" PARTICIPATING FOR THE 5" COTTON CHARM SQUARES SWAP FOR 2020

- 1. Cut 21 CHARM SQUARES, FEBRUARY IS VALENTINE'S OR PINK'S
- 2. Sign in at the squares swap table so we can keep track of participants.
- 3. Put your cut 5" squares on the table in 21 separate piles at the beginning of the meeting.
- 4. Pick up your pile of collected cut squares at the END of the meeting, in order not to disrupt our program.
- 5. The theme for next month's charm. March is Children or Animal prints.

IF ABSENT: You may send your squares by someone else or give to Betty Green or MaryJo Wimberly. The squares need to be labeled with your name and which month's swap it is for. INSTRUCTIONS: Each month members participating will bring 21 cotton charm 5" fabric squares. A different Theme is assigned for each month. *Please cut accurately and use only 100% cotton fabric.*
