Lisa Martin, a Patrick County, Virginia, native and owner of The Wormy Chestnut, will be the guest speaker for our June 8 meeting. Lisa was instrumental in creating the Patrick County Barn Quilt Trail and has been hosting and teaching barn quilt classes for years. Besides talking about the history and nature of barn quilts, she will be bringing a mini patriotic barn quilt ornament project for the group to complete.

In addition, she will have 12" x 12" Barn Quilt Kits available for purchase for **\$30 each** if anyone is interested. She'll be bringing a variety of popular designs and the kits contain the stenciled barn quilt, paints, brushes, and instructions for completion. These small kits are perfect to decorate a mailbox or house sign, to frame and show off in your house, or to adorn a porch or other outdoor setting. **Please bring cash or a check to purchase any kits.**

Lisa will also offer a **BARN QUILT BLOCK workshop** on **Saturday, September 9th**. The cost is \$40 per person, but that includes everything - and she even brings extra cups so if someone doesn't finish, they can take them home.
