Program

Michelle Owens will give a program demonstrating a 3-D bow tie block. If you would like to sew along, bring 5 squares of fabric. Any size works but for the demo smaller is better/faster, maybe 4.5" x 4.5". Three squares should be the same color/print, these will be the bow tie, and two squares should be muslin or a light solid, the background. Also bring sewing supplies...needle, thread, pins, scissors. You can make them by hand or on your sewing machine. There will be a handout with instructions.
