### Gwendolyn Ann Magee

We have local two opportunities to view the quilts of Gwendolyn Ann Magee. She was a graduate of the Woman's College of the University of North Carolina, now the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. Her childhood and early adult years spent in the Triad area of the state were formative in shaping her views, and her adult years as a social work and business professional, wife and mother in Jackson, Mississippi, all contributed to developing the passionate voice she brought to her art work. She found her artistic voice through the fiber arts, and her mastery of the medium enabled her to powerfully express her views and engage her audience. She initiated her distinctive use of fiber techniques through first creating a quilt as a reminder of home for her college---bound daughter, but was soon pushing the limits of the medium to express pain and opportunity, hope and loss. This exhibition will feature twelve pieces as a cohesive body of work in a narrative sequence. The exhibition will also include selected works that emphasize Magee's development through the expression of her continuing social concerns and the honing of her technical skills.
