- 1100 Art Quilt, Abstract** - Original design is non-literal and focuses on color, line, shape, pattern, and texture.
- 1200 Art Quilt, Pictorial** - Original design reflecting innovative construction and design techniques, theme or subject matter and/or materials. Quilt extends beyond traditional disciplines with originality in theory, design, color and/or technique. Quilt must be the original work of entrant. No commercial patterns or copies of previous works
- 1300 Bed Quilts Appliqued, 84” X 90” or Larger** - Appliqué predominates over other techniques in amount and effect. Appliqué method may be hand or machine
- 1400 Bed Quilts Traditional Pieced, 84” X 90” or Larger** - Piecing predominates over other techniques in amount and effect.
- 1500 Bed Quilts Mixed Technique, 84” X 90” or Larger** - Two or more techniques are combined.
- 1600 Bed Quilts Duet, 84” X 90” or Larger** - Made/completed by two people. Usually a piecer and a quilter
- 1700 Bed Quilts Appliqued, 83” X 89” or Smaller** - Appliqué predominates over other techniques in amount and effect. Appliqué method may be hand or machine
- 1800 Bed Quilts Traditional Pieced, 83” X 89” or Smaller** - Piecing predominates over other techniques in amount and effect.
- 1900 Bed Quilts Mixed Technique, 83” X 89” or Smaller** - Two or more techniques are combined.
- 2000 Bed Quilts Duet, 83” X 89” or Smaller** - Made/completed by two people.
- 2100 Group Quilt**- Made/completed by three or more people.
- 2200 Miniature Quilt** - A quilted miniature version of a standard sized quilt with a maximum of 24 inches on a side, and a maximum block size of 4 inches square.
- 2300 Fashion/Wearables** – A quilted item used as clothing or accessory.
- 2400 Home Décor** - A quilted item for home decoration or household use.
- 2500 Modern Quilt** - Follows the modern quilt guidelines as defined by the MQG

- 2600 Novice Quilt** - Entrant has been quilting for less than two years. Please specify as "My First Quilt".
- 2700 Quilt Made from Block of the Month (BOM) or Kits** – Fabrics chosen by and pattern design create by quilt pattern designer or quilt shop.
- 2800 Quilt Made for Children** - Quilt with a child theme and intended for use by a child
- 2900 Quilt Made by Youth** - ages 18 and under
- 3000 Wall Hangings, Large, Perimeter 180" or Larger** -Quilt intended for hanging on a wall.
- 3100 Wall Hangings, Small, Perimeter 179" or Smaller** - Quilt intended for hanging on a wall.
- 3200 Not Judged/Display Only**
- 3300 Current Challenge Quilt** (PQG member's only)
- Previous Challenge Quilt Display** – We are asking all guild members to please let us display your Challenge Quilts from previous PQG shows. The quilts will need to be registered but there is no entry fee.

Member Quilt Entry Fee: \$3.00 per entry - You must be a member at the time of registration. If you would like to join or renew your membership at this time, please enclose a completed Membership Form and a separate check for \$25 (or \$10 if you are 70 and over). Youth entry fee: \$5.00. **Non-Member Quilt Entry Fee:** \$10.00 per entry; Carousel Quilters and Modern Quilt Guild \$7.00 per entry

Quilt Show Entry Rules

The following rules apply to JUDGED quilts only. This information and more detail may be found on the PQG website <http://piedmontquilts.org>

The Quilt Show Committee, Quilt Show Registrar, and/or the Judge reserve the right to re-categorize any quilt as they deem necessary.

1. Quilts must have been completed after January 2017 and not previously entered in a Piedmont Quilters' Guild quilt show.
2. Quilts must be three layers, either quilted or tied, and completed.
3. A 4 inch sleeve must be attached to all quilts, except Miniature Quilts, Miscellaneous Quilts – Home Décor, and Miscellaneous Quilts – Fashion/Wearables.
4. ALL quilts must have a label attached to the back of the quilt which includes, at minimum, the name of the quilt and the maker.
5. Duet quilts are made by 2 people, usually one piecer and one quilter.
6. Size requirements for categories are listed, if applicable, on the entry form and the website.
7. Piedmont Quilters' Guild members may enter an unlimited total number of quilts in the overall show but are limited to only 2 per category.
8. Non-members may enter up to 5 quilts total for the show but are limited to only 2 per category.
9. You may list your quilt for sale.
10. Quilts made from kits or BOMs may be entered only in the designated category.
11. Registrations for ALL quilts are to be handed in or postmarked on or before February 28, 2020.
12. Quilt entry fees: Piedmont Quilters' Guild members - \$3.00, Non-members - \$10.00, Youth - \$5.00, Special Invitees (Greensboro Modern Quilt Guild members and Carousel Quilters Guild members) - \$7.00 There are no entry fees for Challenge Quilts or the Previous Challenge Quilt Display.
13. Completed quilts must be received in a pillowcase (or other cloth container). The pillowcase should have a label with the name of the quilt and the maker of the quilt. Exceptions may be made for art quilts that cannot be folded.

Display Only Quilts (includes Previous Challenge Quilt Display)

1. Have no entry fee.
2. Must have a 4 inch sleeve attached.
3. Must have a label attached to quilt back.
4. Must be handed in or postmarked on or before February 28, 2020.
5. Must be received on or before March 14, 2020 in a labeled pillowcase (or other cloth container).
