## Guild Activities and Opportunities

### Day in the Park, September 16th

Volunteers are needed for Day in the Park on Saturday, September 16th at High Point City Lake Park in Jamestown from 11am to 5pm. We usually work in two shifts - 10am to 2pm (includes set up) and 1pm to 5pm (includes take down). We will be at the same location as last year, under a tent near the entrance. Last year we had lots of kids stop by to learn how to hand quilt an ornament. This year we will also have Raffle Quilt Tickets for sale. There should be at least 3 people per shift but more people would be even better! You just need to bring your chair and perhaps some hand-work to demo and talk about and maybe a small quilt/wall hanging or two to show if someone wants to talk about quilting.
